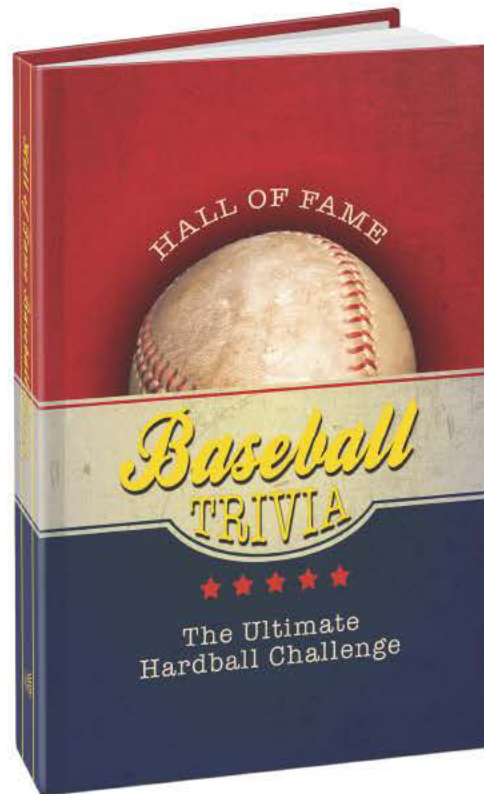
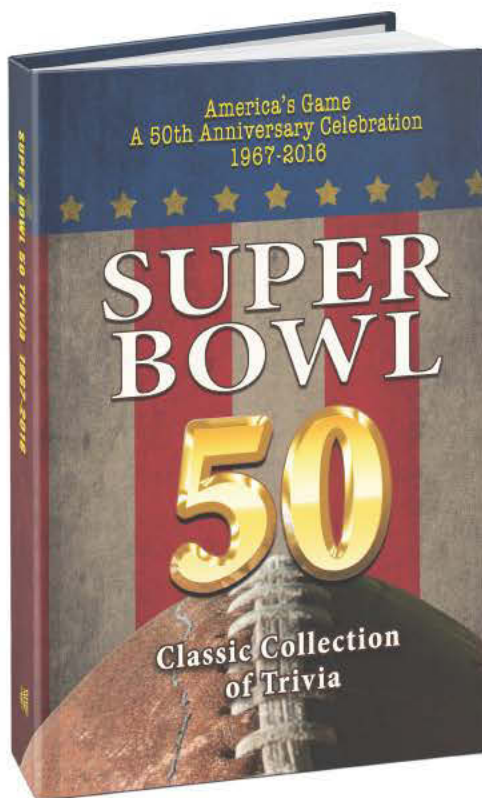

5. In their Super Bowl XXVII rout of the Bills, two Cowboys scored defensive touchdowns. Can you name either?

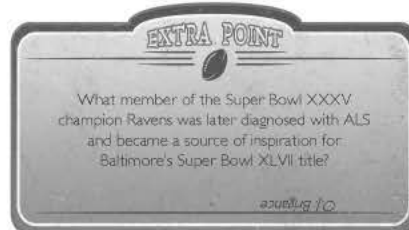

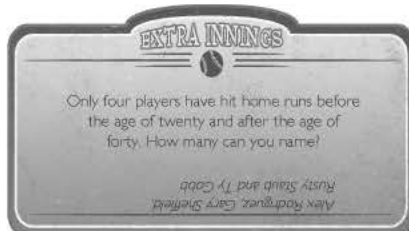
